## NEW ZIPLINE & CHAIRLIFT RIDES ADD TO GORE'S SUMMER ACTIVITIES

NORTH CREEK, NY- Gore Mountain is open Thursday-Sunday for [summer fun](#), and has two more activities for guests to enjoy! A new zipline ride offers family-friendly adventure, when up to two people at a time can soar for about 300' over the Base Area. Also, open-air chairlift rides aboard the high-speed Adirondack Express will alternate with the traditional Northwoods Gondola rides to provide another option for taking in the beautiful views and accessing a variety of hiking and mountain biking terrain.

New [Picnic Basket Lunches](#) are available from the sundeck's Open Pit Grille, complete with a picnic blanket to take on the mountain! The Grille also offers a variety of summer classics for lunch or snacks.

Two new [downhill mountain bike trails](#), Ridge Runner (expert) and Sidetracked (intermediate), have been added to the summer/fall map, and several of the existing trails have been improved for a smoother ride.
