TICKETS / ENTRY

Please have your Ticket(s) saved on your phone or printed before you arrive on venue. If you are in need of additional tickets or have a promotional voucher to redeem, please go to the tickets location at the UCI Tickets / Drop Off Zone.

ACCESSIBILITY

Parking | We have designated Accessibility Parking close to the Mountain Pass Lodge – please drive through the UCI Tickets / Drop Off Zone to acquire your parking pass.

Accessible Spectating | There is access to flat smooth surfaces for spectator viewing near Start/Finish

Accessible Restrooms | Portable restrooms will be available around event and in Mountain Pass Lodge

PARKING & SHUTTLES

Please note – if you do not have paid parking or VIP tickets for Saturday and Sunday – you must use the shuttle system as outline below.

FRIDAY:

- Free parking available at Mt Van Hoevenberg. Located at UCI Tickets / Shuttle Drop Off Zone area

SATURDAY:

- **\$20 Onsite parking** available at Mt Van Hoevenberg (must purchase in advance online). Located at the UCI Tickets/ Shuttle Drop off Zone area.
- **Free parking** available at the North Elba Athletic Fields with shuttle service to Mt Van Hoevenberg UCI Tickets / Shuttle Drop Off Zone area

RV Parking is available (but limited) at the Lake Placid airport, guests can sign up in advance online at LakePlacid.com

No overnight parking anywhere on venue for guests and spectators. No camping on venue.

All spectators should expect to walk approximately 800 meters from the UCI Tickets /Drop Off Zone to the main entry of the Vendor Village.

For guests who have limited mobility or need assistance, we have a shuttle that can be provided to you - please ask an attendant at the UCI Tickets / Shuttle Drop Off Zone.

THULE BIKE CHECK - FREE COURTESY OF THULE

A bike check will be available should you wish to ride to the event and check your bike. Like a bag or coat check, your bike will be tagged and you will be given a corresponding number to your bike. The bike check is located at the entrance of the EXPO Village. If you have all necessary tickets for entry, you may proceed from the main access road directly to the EXPO Village entry. Mountain Biking at Mt Van Hoevenberg will not be accessible during the event.

WHAT CAN I BRING?

For a safe and secure experience, bag/cooler checks are at all entrances during events at Mt Van Hoevenberg. Thank you for your understanding as we prioritize visitor safety.

Acceptable Items include, but are not limited to:

Chairs, backpacks, coolers, bikes (there is a bike check), blankets, noisemakers, cameras, hiking shoes

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Glass containers
- Alcohol
- Firearms
- Explosive and/or incendiary devices
- Noxious material
- Electronic stun guns
- Assault-type items or devices
- Edged weapons
- Nuisance items & devices
- Restraining type items & devices
- Miscellaneous items deemed inappropriate by security staff

VIP TICKET HOLDERS

VIP Ticket Holders should drive up to the UCI Tickets / Drop Off Zone where they will be met by ambassadors at their car and given a parking pass and credentials. Once parked, VIP's should head to the Mountain Pass Lodge, second floor, and retrieve their VIP package and information.

VIPs have access to the 2nd floor of the Mountain Pass Lodge, where there will be food, beverages, entertainment, and an auto-graph session. Additionally, VIPs have access to a special viewing location outside near the finish area, and can sign up for the Mt Van Hoevenberg Tour at our Guest Services location on the 2nd floor.

RESTROOMS

There will be portable restrooms set up throughout the venue for all guests. Accessible bathrooms will also be available. A parent and child room will be located in the Mountain Pass Lodge 1st Floor for guardians of young children.

SEATING

There is no seating provided in the General Admission spectator viewing area for this event, however you may BYOC (Bring Your Own Chair).

GUEST SERVICES/LOST AND FOUND

Guest Services and Lost and Found will be located near the entrance/exit of the EXPO Village

FIRST AID

First Aid will be located near the entrance/exit of the EXPO Village

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Food and beverages will be located throughout the venue outside, vendors accepting cash and credit cards.

For VIP guests - food and beverages will be available on the 2nd Floor of the Mountain Pass Lodge. VIPs will be provided with drink tickets to be used for alcoholic beverages. Non-alcoholic beverages are unlimited for VIPs

UCI Official Merchandise can be found in three locations: entrance of the EXPO village, 1st Floor of Mountain Pass Lodge, and for VIPs, 2nd Floor of the Mountain Pass Lodge

In addition to UCI Official Merchandise, you will find Mt Van Hoevenberg Merchandise and Apparel on the 1st Floor of the Mountain Pass Lodge.
